

2015 New York Assessment Highlights

(TESTING GRADES 3 AND 4)

BRIGHTER CHOICE CHARTER SCHOOL FOR BOYS HAS NOTABLE PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS

Brighter Choice Charter School for Boys 3rd and 4th graders rank 1st in Math proficiency out of all Albany District Elementary Schools: BCCS-B 3rd graders achieved 45% proficient and 4th graders achieved 68% proficient, outperforming all Albany District Schools and NYS average.

A growing number of Brighter Choice Charter School for Boys students advanced in Math: 39% of BCCS-B 4th graders scored advanced in Math, compared to the District which only had 5% of male students achieving advanced results.

SPOTLIGHT

Brighter Choice Charter School for Boys ranked 1st in 3rd grade Math and 4th grade Math and ELA out of all other local Charter schools and the District's overall average.

STRONG RESULTS IN ELA AND MATH

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

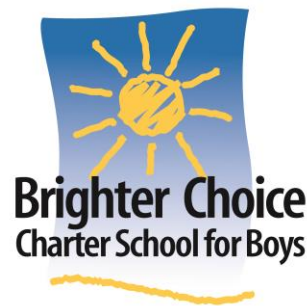
Proficiency: 35% of 3rd and 4th Grade students were proficient in ELA, compared to the District where 20% of male students were proficient in the same grades.

Growth: ELA performance improved by 7 percentage points, from 25% to 32% in 4th grade. By comparison, in the same grade, the District remained the same, 11%.

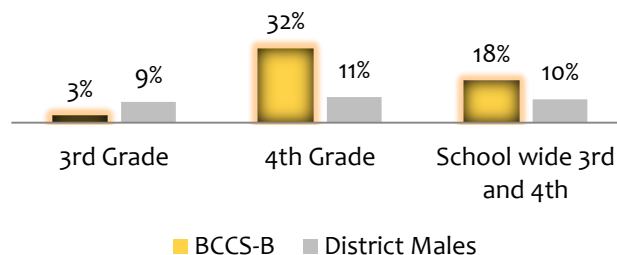
MATH

Proficiency: 45% of 3rd graders and 68% of 4th graders were proficient in Math, more than 3 times that of District males (15% proficient for the same grades).

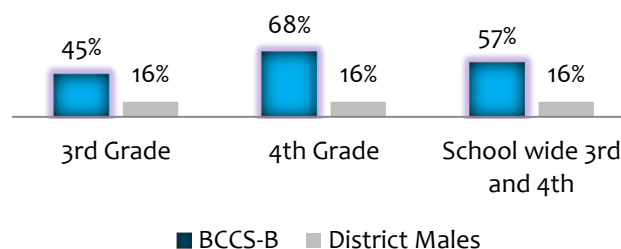
Growth: In 4th grade, Math performance increased significantly from 25% in 2014 to 68% in 2015, while District score for 4th grade males declined from 17% to 16% over the same period.



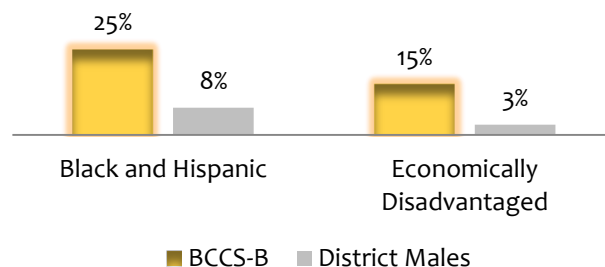
ELA PROFICIENCY RATES
