

2017 New York Assessment Highlights

(TESTING GRADES 3, 4 AND 5TH)

BRIGHTER CHOICE CHARTER SCHOOL FOR BOYS HAS NOTABLE PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS

Brighter Choice Charter School for Boys 3rd and 4th graders outperformed Albany's City School District for both Math and ELA: BCCS-B 3rd graders achieved 33% proficient, 4th graders achieved 33% proficient in ELA, outperforming Albany District Schools.

An admirable number of Brighter Choice Charter School for Boys students advanced in Math: 37% of BCCS-B 3rd graders were proficient in Math, compared to the District which had 24% of students achieving advanced results. 29% of BCCS-B 4th graders were proficient in Math, compared to the District which had 14% of students achieving advanced results. 29% of 5th graders were proficient in Math, compared to the District which had 15% of students achieving advanced results.

Brighter Choice Charter School for Boys outranked the Albany's City School District overall average for 3rd Math and ELA, 4th Math and ELA and 5th Math.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

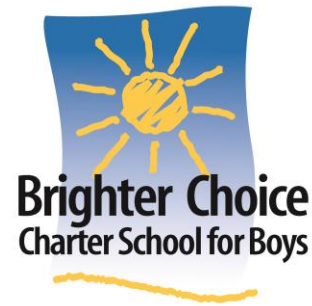
Proficiency: 83% of 3rd, 4th and 5th Grade students were proficient in ELA, compared to the District where 57% of students were proficient in the same grades.

MATH

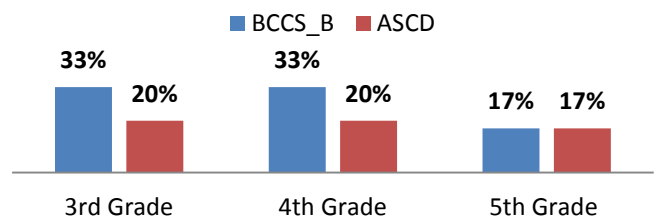
Proficiency: 95% of 3rd, 4th and 5th Grade students were proficient in ELA, compared to the District where 53% of students were proficient in the same grades.

Growth

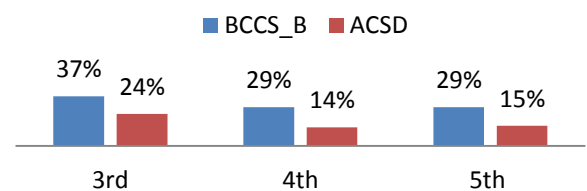
3rd and 4th cohort performance increased 10% points. 3rd grade math overall performance average increased 18% points compared to the district's increase of 7% points.



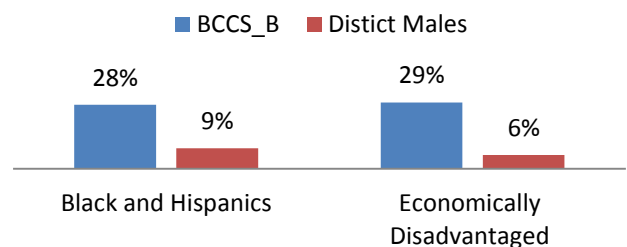
ELA PROFICIENCY RATE
