

2018 New York Assessment Highlights

(TESTING GRADES 3, 4 AND 5TH)

BRIGHTER CHOICE CHARTER SCHOOL FOR BOYS HAS NOTABLE PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS

Brighter Choice Charter School for Boys 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders outperformed Albany's City School District for both Math and ELA: BCCS-B 3rd graders achieved 68% proficient, 4th graders achieved 56% and 5th graders achieved 39% proficient in ELA, outperforming Albany District Schools.

An admirable number of Brighter Choice Charter School for Boys students advanced in Math: 35% of BCCS-B 3rd graders were proficient in Math, compared to the District which had 25% of students achieving advanced results. 29% of BCCS-B 4th graders were proficient in Math, compared to the District which had 20% of students achieving advanced results. 45% of 5th graders were proficient in Math, compared to the District which had 16% of students achieving advanced results.

Brighter Choice Charter School for Boys outranked the Albany's City School District overall average for both Math and ELA in 3rd-5th grades.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

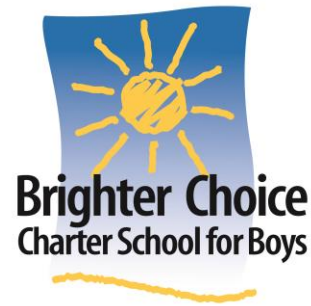
Proficiency: 54% of 3rd, 4th and 5th Grade students were proficient in ELA, compared to the District where 23% of students were proficient in the same grades.

MATH

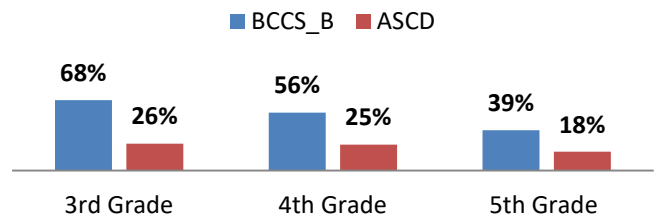
Proficiency: 36% of 3rd, 4th and 5th Grade students were proficient in Math, compared to the District where 20% of students were proficient in the same grades.

Growth

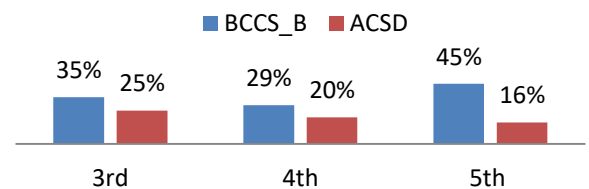
3rd cohort performance increased 23% points and 4th cohort performance increased 6% points for ELA. 4th cohort performance increased 16% points for Math.



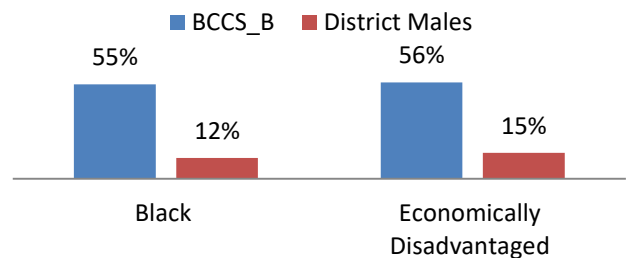
ELA PROFICIENCY RATE
