Testing Plan:

Brighter choice will follow CDC guidance and will work with the local health department to determine when individuals, particularly students, who screened positive for COVID-19 symptoms can return to the in-person learning environment at school. The following protocol includes:

- 1. Documentation from a health care provider following evaluation,
- 2. Negative COVID-19 diagnostic test result,
- 3. Symptom resolution as recommended by the Department of Health, or,
- 4. If a person is placed under mandatory quarantine by the local Health Department, they may not return to school until that quarantine is over.
