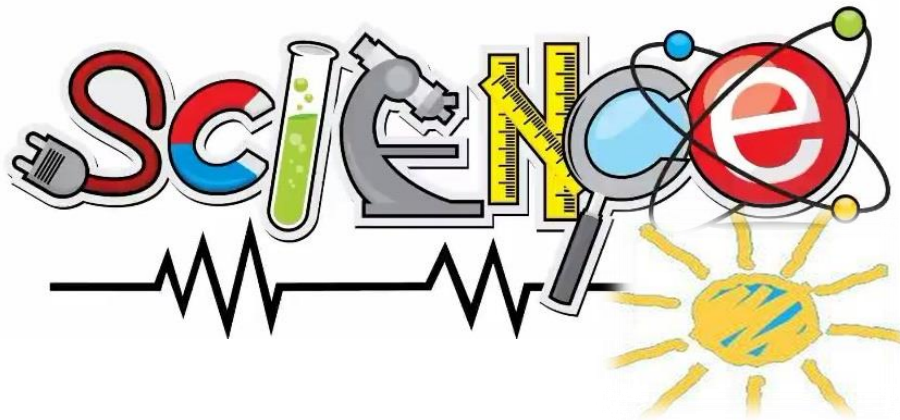

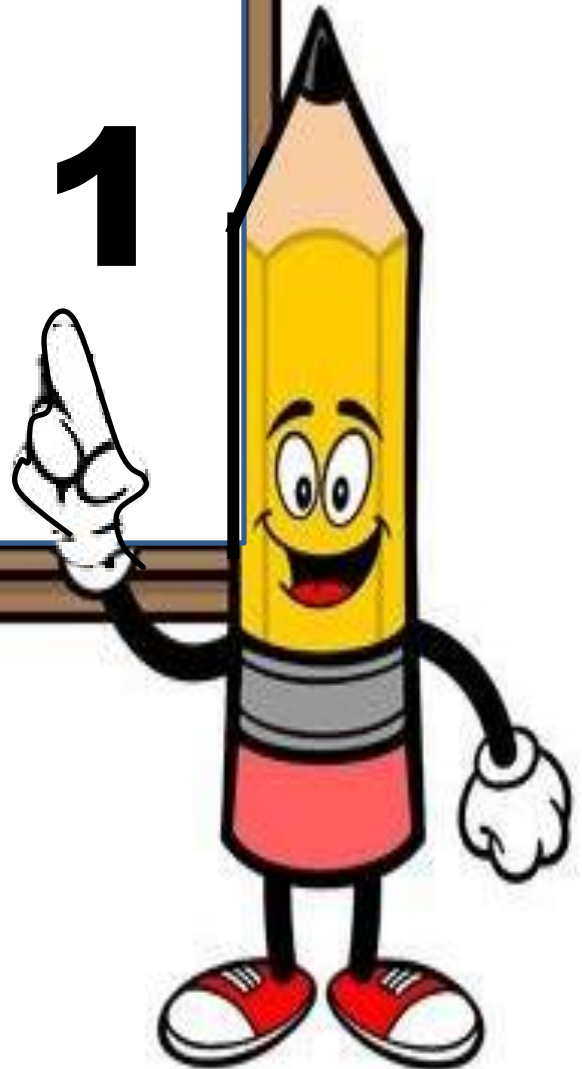

Keya needed to get to the ice cream truck, but she was barefooted and the pavement was hot.

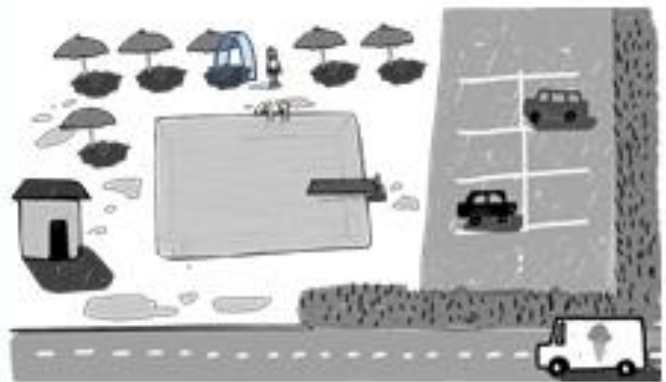


Keya was to go swimming but the ice cream truck came and it was too hot outside.



How did she solve her problem of walking to the ice cream truck without shoes on the hot pavement?

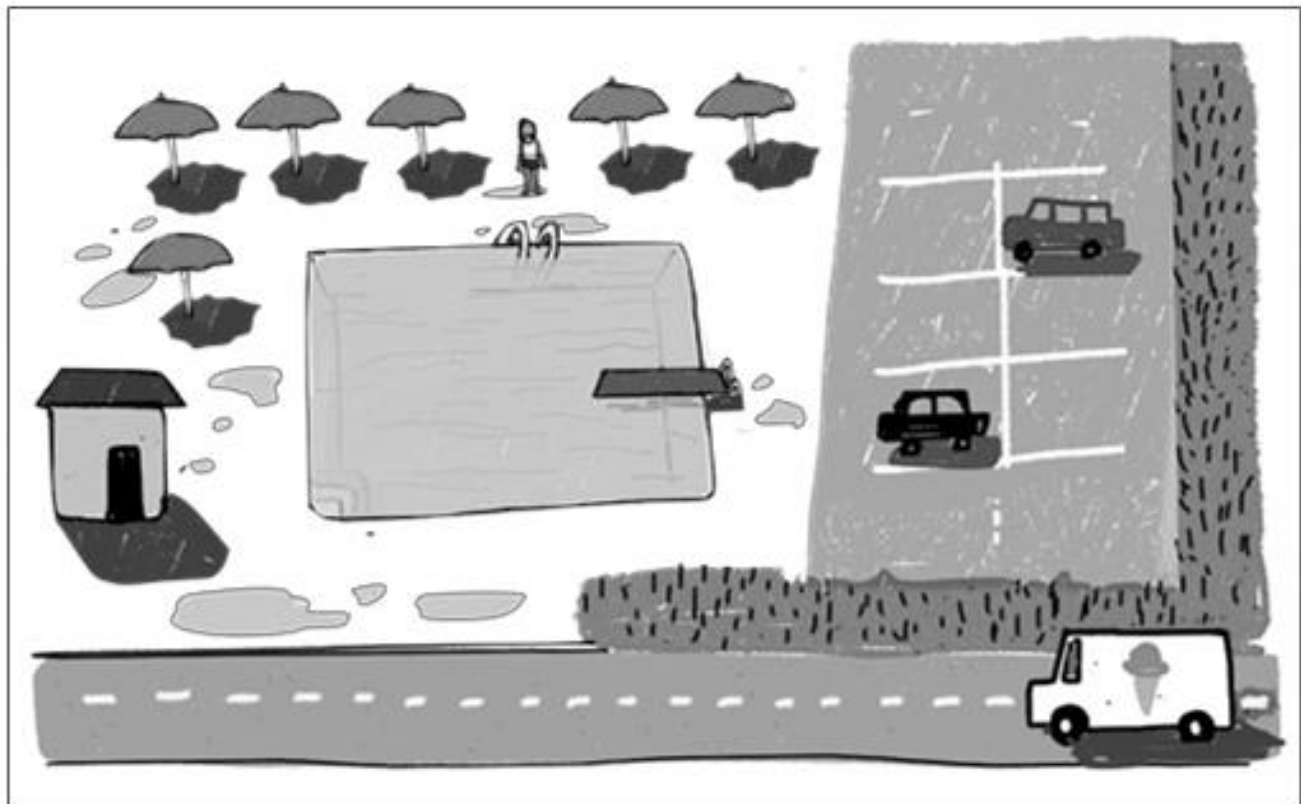
