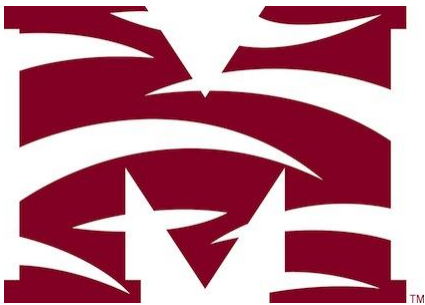

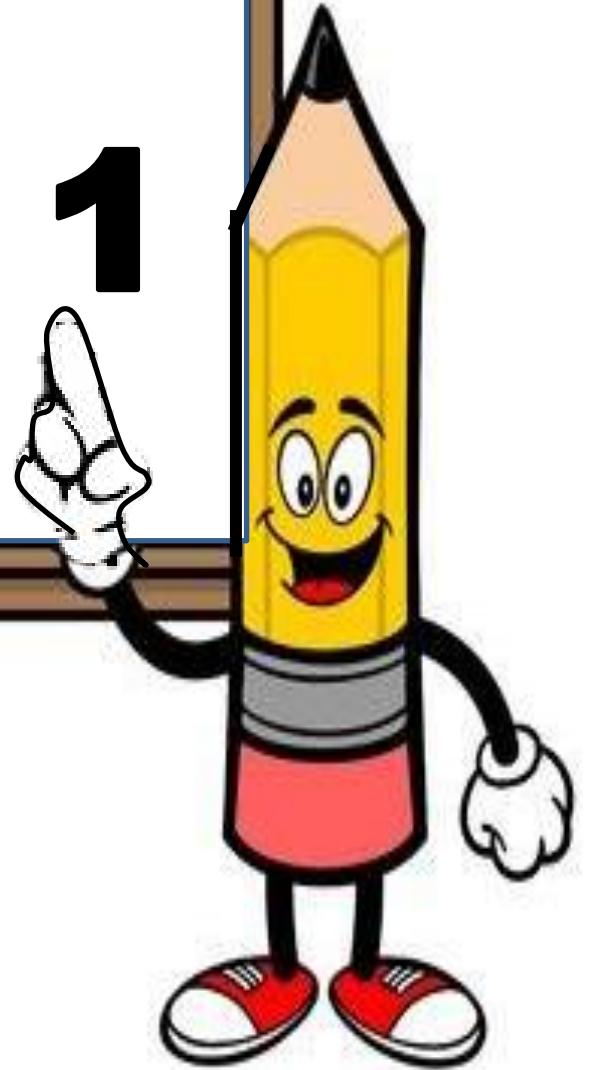

	choose/chooses	chose	(has, have) chosen
	give/gives	gave	(has, have) given

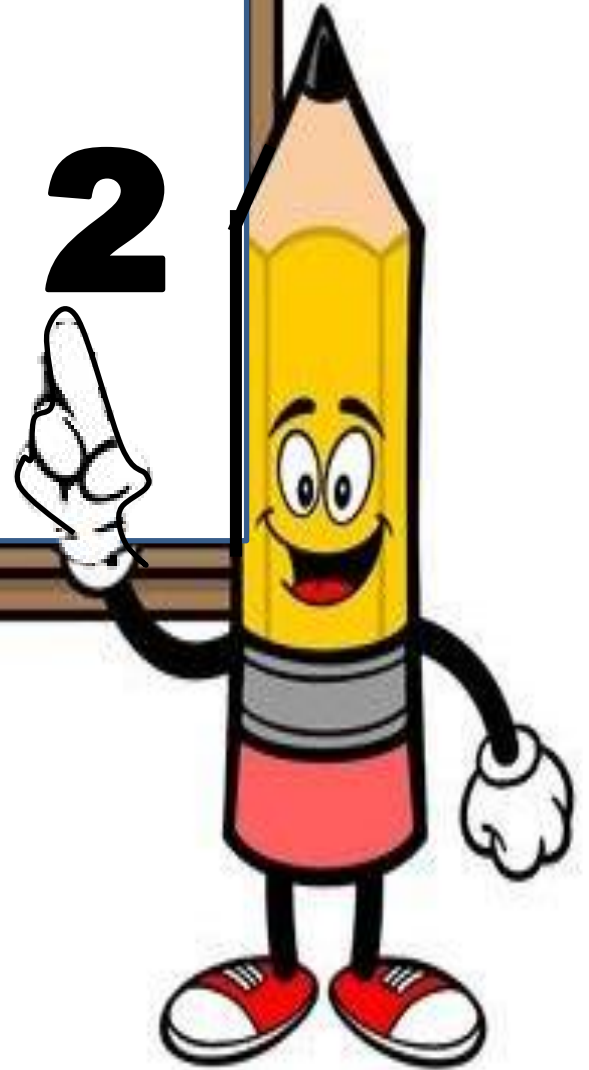

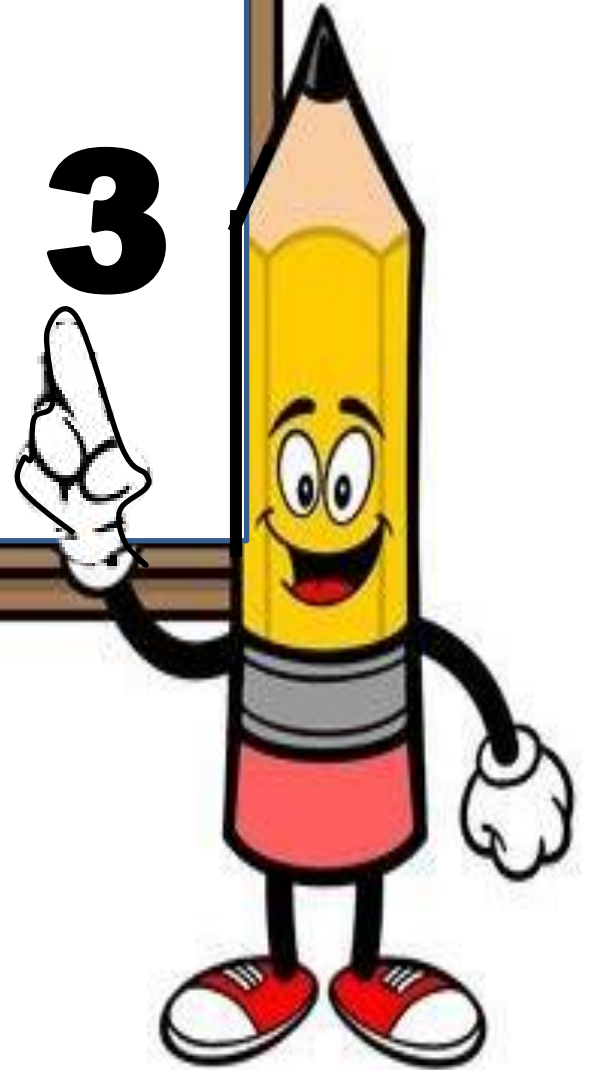

To Be in the Present and Past

Forms of the verb *to be* link the subject of a sentence to words in the rest of the sentence. It is important to use this verb correctly.

Present

I am you are

he is

she is

it is

cat is

we are you are

they are

cats are

Past

I was

you were

he was

she was

it was

cat was

we were

you were

they were

cats were

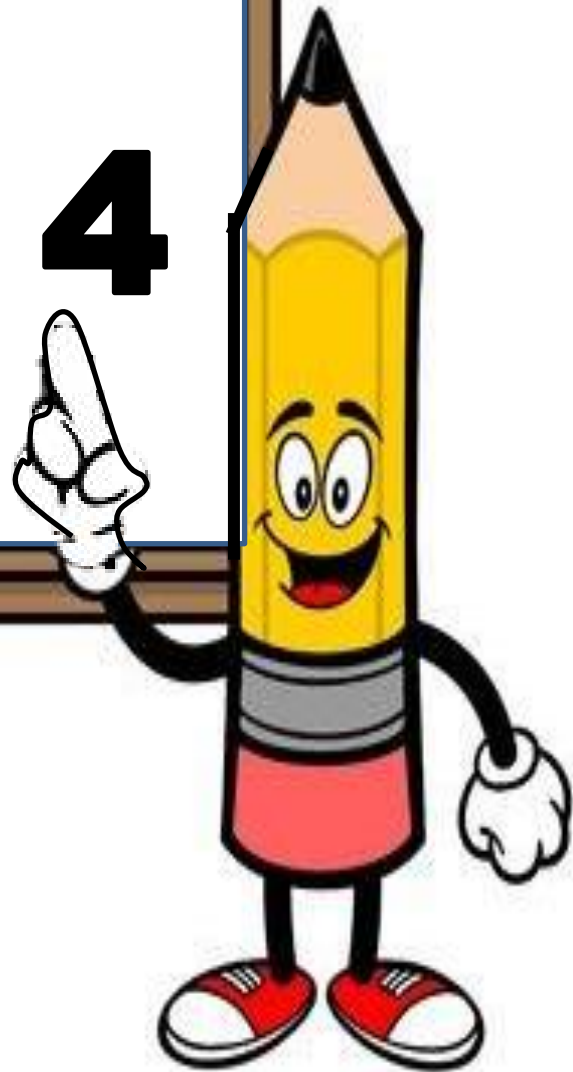

Helping Verbs

Forms of the verb *to be* can be used as main verbs or helping verbs. Some forms—*be*, *being*, and *been*—can only be used with helping verbs.

Forms of To Be: am, is, are was, were be, being, been

I am watching the cat. The cat is purring.
