The first player picks one or two items

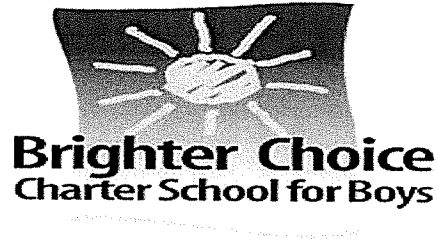
The second player (the other) picks one or two items
