
Types of Sentences

Statements, questions, commands, and exclamations are different kinds of sentences.


Kind of Sentence	Punctuation used	Example
Declarative - makes a statement.	Period .	Mark makes his lunch every day.
Interrogative - asks a question	Question mark ?	What does he usually eat?
Imperative - gives a command.	Period or exclamation mark . or !	Clean off the counter.
Exclamatory - shows strong feeling.	Exclamation mark !	Hurry up!

Kind of Sentence	Punctuation used	Example
Declarative - makes a statement.	Period .	This Sunday, we're going on a picnic
Interrogative - asks a question	Question mark ?	Would you like to join us?
Imperative - gives a command.	Period or exclamation mark . or !	Tell us by Saturday.
Exclamatory - shows strong feeling.	Exclamation mark !	Absolutely!
