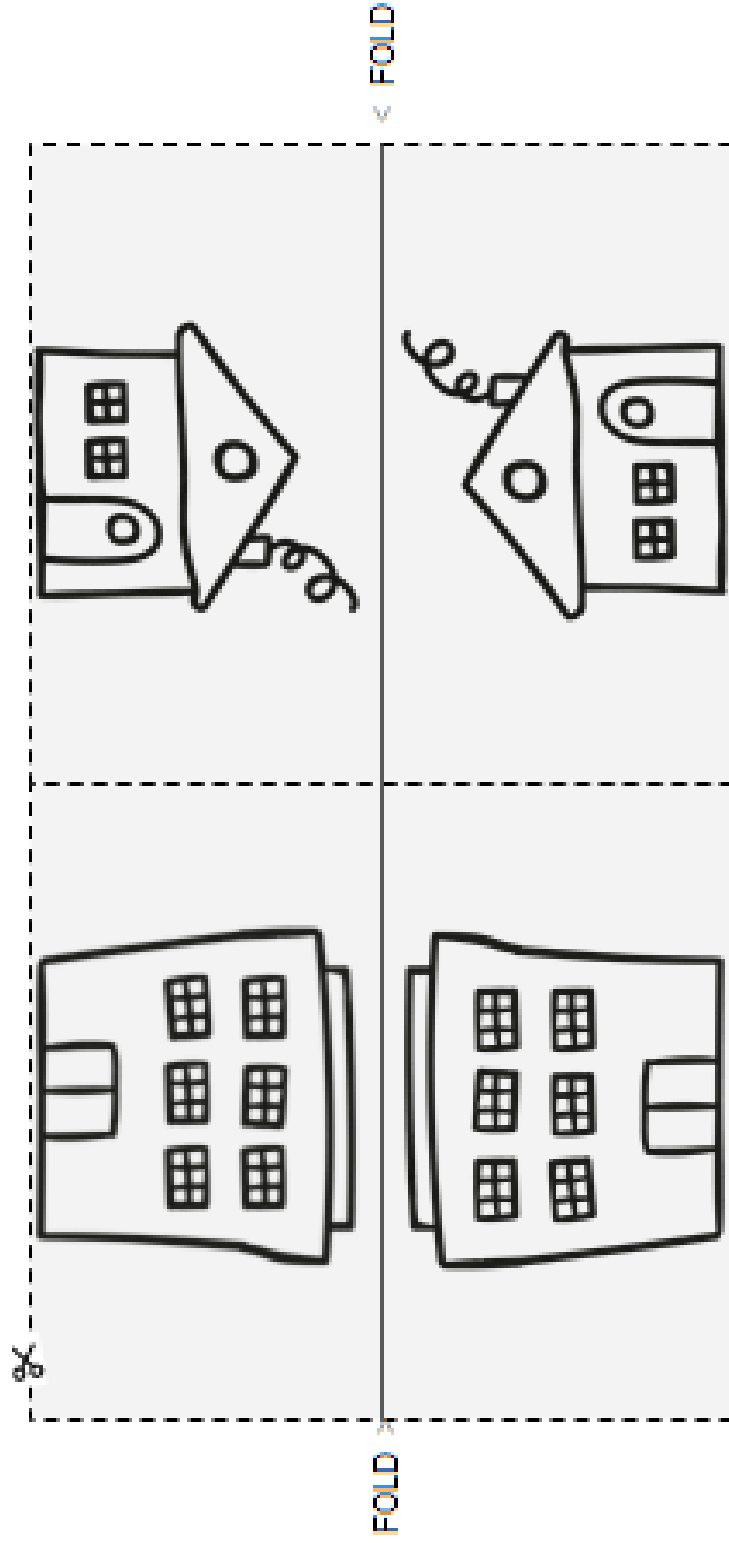
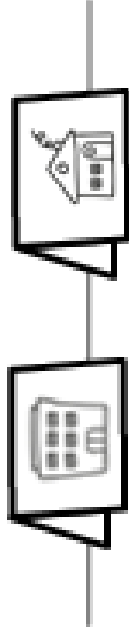


Game Board, page 2 – line this up with Gameboard page 1 at 'A' and 'B' and tape to the floor

PREP THE HOUSES: Cut the dotted lines so you have 2 house templates. Fold on the solid lines so they stand up like this:

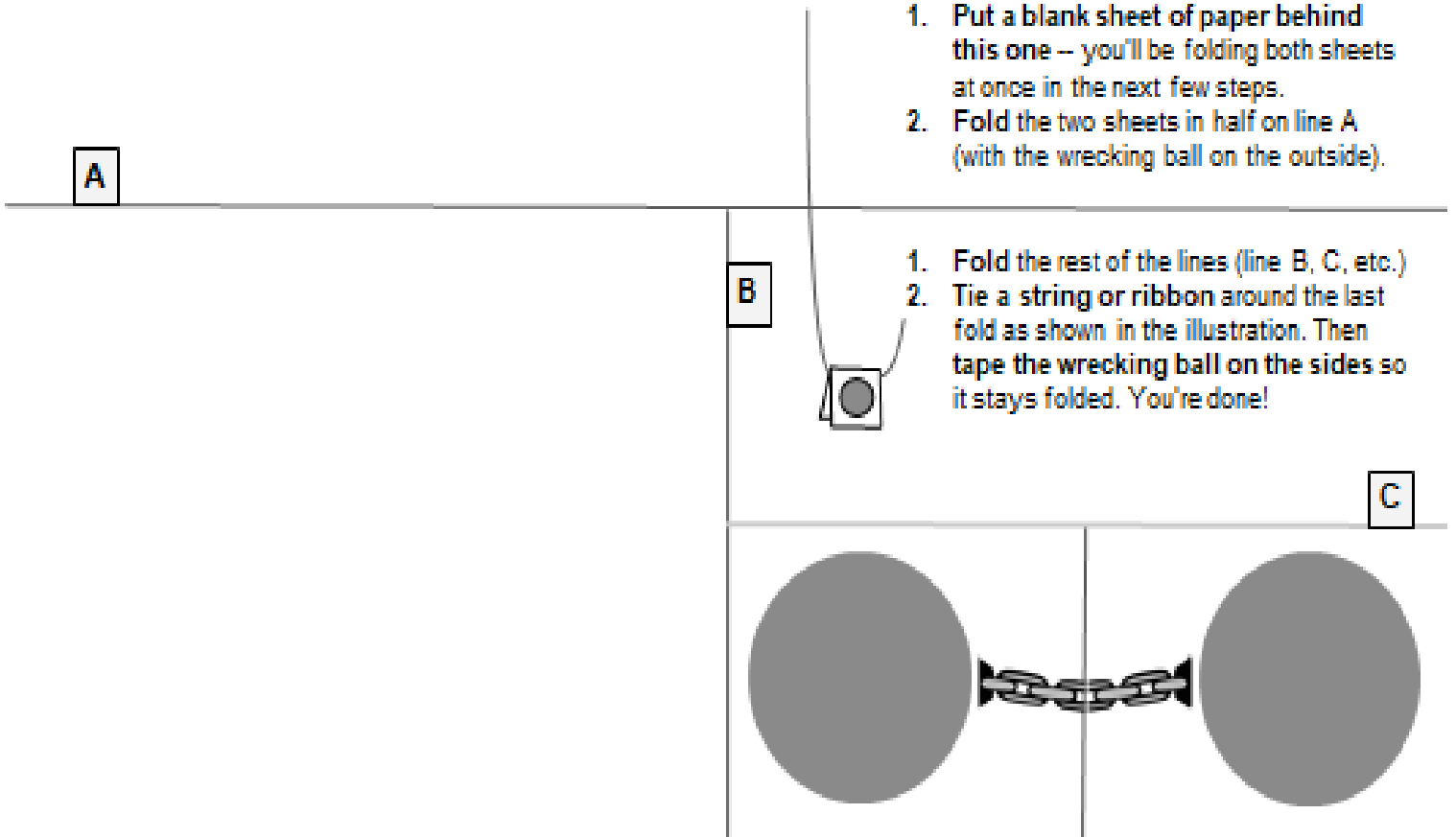


The Foldable Houses

The Foldable Wrecking Ball

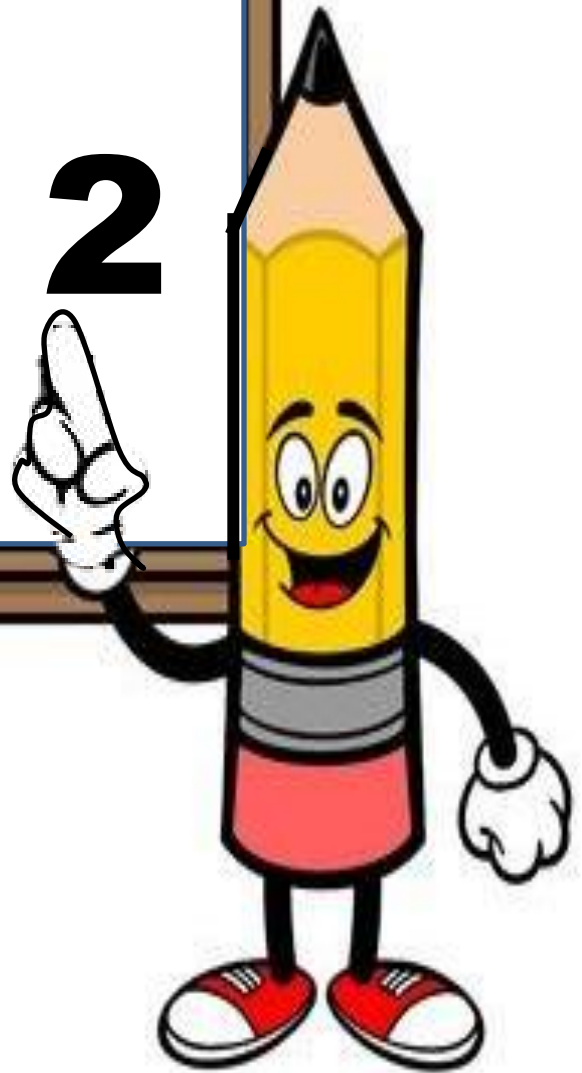
PREP THE WRECKING BALL:

What did Daniel need to do to knock down a lot of pins?

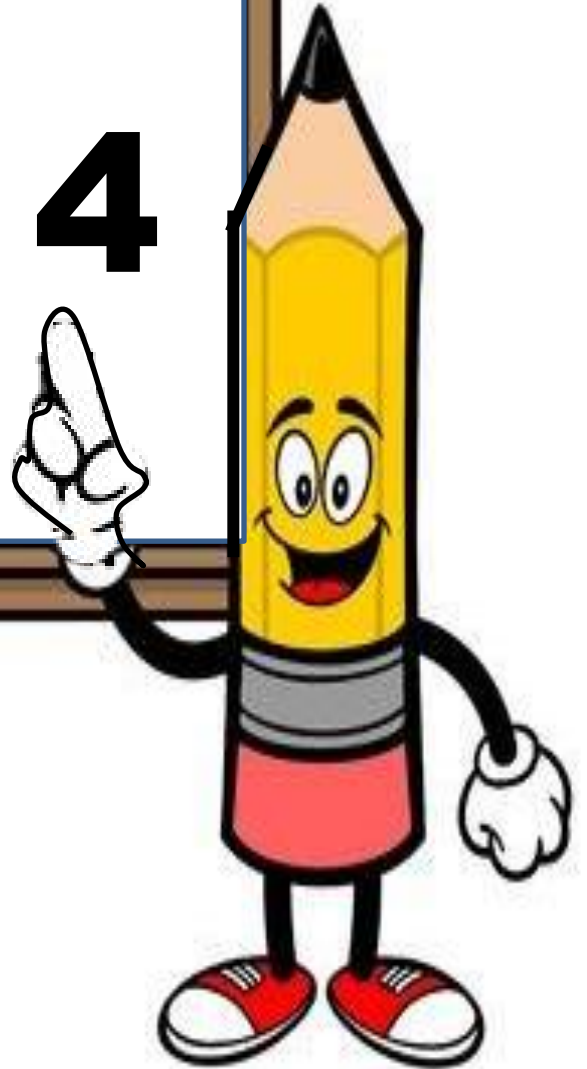

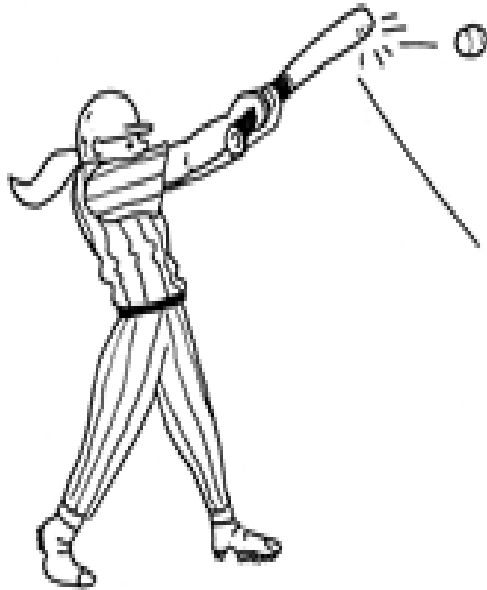
