






The Temperate Forest

A temperate forest, also known as the woodlands is full of plant life including a variety of trees and bushes. Many creatures including insects, snakes, wildcats, birds, bears and other small mammals call these forests their home. Some live in or on the trees and many graze through the plant life on the forest floor. The word temperate means not too

extreme, referring to the temperature. The **temperate** forest doesn't get really hot or cold throughout the year, ranging from 30 to 90 degrees **Fahrenheit**. Having the four seasons of summer, fall, winter and spring along with a good amount of rain are also features of the **temperate** forest. Some of the places these forests can be found are North America, Europe and Asia.
