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Spelling Past Tense Verbs

The past tense of most verbs ends in *-ed*. For some verbs you have to change the spelling before adding *-ed*. If a verb has one syllable and ends with a vowel followed by a consonant, double the final consonant before adding *-ed*. **drop** \rightarrow **dropped tag** \rightarrow **tagged** If a verb ends with *e*, drop the e before adding *-ed*. **dance** \rightarrow **danced bake** \rightarrow **baked** If a verb ends with a consonant and *y*, change the *y* to *i* before adding *-ed*. **hurry** \rightarrow **hurried worry** \rightarrow **worried**
