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Helping Verbs

Forms of the verb to be can be used as main verbs or helping verbs.

Some forms—be, being, and been—can only be used with helping verbs.

Forms of To Be: am, is, are was, were be, being, been

I am watching the cat. The cat is purring.

helping verb main verb helping verb main verb
